

Form 5: LEPG Artifact Submission Form

Purpose

The purpose of self-reflection is to focus on strengths and opportunities for growth according to the LEPG Core Propositions and Standards. This reflection will guide the development of professional growth goals.

During the beginning of the year conference, leaders and their evaluators will determine a list of artifacts that the leader will submit at middle and the end of the current school year. The list should provide evidence for specific LEPG Rubric Core Propositions or Standards that demonstrate the leader's desired level of performance. Throughout the school year, the leaders will collect the artifacts and evidence and complete the *Summary of Leader's Evidence Collection* table below.

In the table, identify the title of the document you are submitting as evidence of your practice and the Core Proposition(s) and/or Standard(s) it aligns with. Then provide a summary what the document highlights about your practice. It is recommended that you only include 5-8 pieces of evidence for submission, so consider selecting a small number of high quality authentic examples of your practice. Bring this completed form and the artifacts to your mid-course and summative conferences for discussion, analysis, and review.
