

## Bullying Consequence Rubric

Bullying is intentionally hurtful behavior toward another student. It includes physical abuse, verbal abuse, or exclusion. All bullying behavior results in a consequence as follows. All instances of bullying are documented on the behavior forms with a copy given to each classroom teacher and the Principal.

<b>Malicious/Serious Bullying</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Punching</li> <li>• Kicking</li> <li>• Tackling</li> <li>• Stealing</li> </ul>	Send immediately to Principal  1/2 day in-school suspension  Student calls home  Mail home behavior form	Send immediately to Principal  One day in-school suspension  Student calls home  Mail home behavior form  Parents must attend a meeting at school	Send immediately to Principal  One day of out of school suspension  Student calls home  Mail home behavior form  Parents must attend a meeting at school

- Students get a clean slate at the end of each trimester.
- All consequences are subject to the situation and the discretion of the Principal.
