

CLASS SIZE

The Board recognizes that a relationship exists between class size and pupil achievement. This relationship varies across grade levels, among subjects, and by methods of instruction. Therefore, average class size in grades K-8 and student loads in grades 9-12 shall be determined by several different variables, including grade level, subject, particular needs of the student, learning objectives, instructional methods, input of staff, budgetary constraints, and available space. The Board seeks to balance this interest with the cost of the education of our students. The Board directs the Superintendent to work with principals in attempting to establish a reasonable and equitable class enrollment for the personalizing of the educational program to enhance the educational success of all learners.
