ANNUAL NOTIFICATION
OF
ASBESTOS-CONTAINING BUILDING MATERIALS

MSAD # 55 has inspected all school buildings for the presence of suspect asbestos-containing building materials in accordance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) EPA 40 CFR 763. A written plan for the management of these materials has been maintained by Atlantic Environmental Contractors, Inc. of Lewiston, Maine.

The AHERA Management Plan is available for inspection by the general public at the Superintendent's Office. The plans may be inspected during normal office hours, an appointment should be made. Copies of the plans can be provided at a cost of 15 cents per page.

The Management Plan is a guidance document outlining operational procedures designed for the proper maintenance and safety of all people who work, study, or are otherwise present in any of the following facilities:

Baldwin Consolidated
