

## SCHOLARSHIP TRUST FUNDS

Sheila Atwell Scholarship: In memory of Sheila Atwell, this scholarship will be awarded to a student of the district who plans to enter the field of education.

John Ellis Barnes Memorial Scholarship: In memory of John Barnes of Hiram, this scholarship is presented each year to the student who has demonstrated his/her worthiness by virtue of outstanding personality; contribution to harmony in class and school; and kindness and consideration toward others.

Dr. Lowell E. Barnes Memorial: This scholarship goes to the student that strives for improvement, a worker, good citizen, someone aware of his or her peers and willing to help others, and has leadership potential.

Dr. Lowell Barnes Scholarship: This scholarship will be awarded to a student pursuing studies of ecology and wildlife preservation in maintaining the environment.

Warren Bucknell Scholarship: This scholarship is in memory of Warren Bucknell. This scholarship is to be awarded annually to a student who has excelled in science at Sacopee Valley High School and who has shown interest in pursuing science.

James A. Campbell Valedictory Fund: In memory of James A. Campbell, first valedictorian of Sacopee Valley High School; to be used for the annual Valedictorian Award.

Eleanor Clinch Memorial Scholarship: This scholarship is to be awarded to any student of the district who plans to enter the field of education.

Etta Collins Scholarship: In memory of Etta Collins of Kezar Falls, this scholarship is awarded each year to a deserving student.

Linda Curtis Memorial Scholarship: Named in honor of Linda Curtis, formerly of Kezar Falls, to be awarded annually to a deserving student or students.

Evelyn Day Scholarship: In memory of Evelyn Day, a former Kezar Falls teacher. This scholarship is to be added to the scholarship in her memory sponsored by the LMR Club, '21 Club, Keswick Club, and the Cornish-Kezar Falls Kiwanis Club. Given annually to a graduate of Sacopee, who is planning on entering the teaching field, in his/her second college year from Parsonsfield, Porter, or South Hiram.

Philip Day Memorial Scholarship: Named in honor of Philip Day, former resident of Cornish, to be awarded annually to a worthy and needy graduate.

Eastman, Tripp, Sprague Trust Fund: In commemoration of James Eastman, Elizabeth Tripp and Marcia W. Sprague. This scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in a post secondary education program and a resident of Hiram or Porter.

Ellie Frost Scholarship: This scholarship will be awarded annually to a Sacopee graduate who is pursuing a degree in the field of education.

Eleanor Garner Memorial Scholarship: In memory of Eleanor Garner of Kezar Falls, librarian, teacher, and friend to all students at Porter High School and Sacopee Valley High School for 15 years. This scholarship is awarded annually to a deserving student or students.

David E. Hasty Memorial Scholarship: In memory of David E. Hasty of Parsonsfield, Sacopee Graduate, Class of 1971. This Scholarship is presented each year to a deserving student who has demonstrated strength of character, a sense of humor, and a good-natured approach to life, in spite of personal challenges. First consideration being given to an eligible student from Parsonsfield.

Hoyt/Neal Scholarship: In honor of Cindy Hoyt and Warren Neal, longtime educators at Sacopee Valley High School. This scholarship is to be awarded annually to a deserving student or students.

Dr. John G. Hoyt Scholarship: In honor of Dr. John G. Hoyt, Superintendent of MSAD #55 from 1968 to 1987, this scholarship is to be awarded annually to a deserving student or students.

Samuel Hoyt & Cindy Hoyt Scholarship: In memory of Samuel & Cindy Hoyt of Cornish, this scholarship is to be awarded annually to a deserving student or students.

Donald & Deborah Isaacs Scholarship: This scholarship will be awarded to students who are well balanced, having exhibited a sincere interest and effort in their academic studies, the arts, sports and community service.

Kezar Falls-Cornish Kiwanis Scholarship: In memory of Samuel Hoyt and Dennis (Pat) Delaney. To be awarded to the valedictorian providing they will be attending a four year college.

Barbara H. Kendall Education Fund: In memory of Barbara H. Kendall of Cornish, long term member of the Board of Directors of the Sacopee Valley School District; to be used to fund special education projects.

Andrew Lalancette/Glendon Buzzell Sr. Memorial Scholarship: In memory of Andrew "Grib" Lalancette and Glendon Buzzell Sr., this scholarship is to be awarded annually to a deserving student from Baldwin.

William F. Lawrence Memorial Trust: This scholarship will be awarded to an eligible student who has demonstrated leadership and scholarship during his or her four years of high school, first consideration being an eligible student from Parsonsfield.

Brian Leavitt Memorial Scholarship: In memory of Brian L. Leavitt of Kezar Falls, this scholarship is to be awarded annually to a deserving student or students.

David Lombard Memorial Scholarship: In memory of David Lombard of Kezar Falls and the Maine State Police. This scholarship is presented each year to a student preferably pursuing a career in Law Enforcement.

Larry Lord Scholarship: In honor of Larry Lord, retired Principal of Sacopee Valley High School and long time educator in MSAD #55 for 25 years. This scholarship is to be awarded annually preferably to a student or students entering the teaching profession; secondly, to a student or students entering one of the protective professions, i.e. law enforcement, fire professional, paramedic, etc.; thirdly, any student attending a school of higher learning.

Maine Community Foundation Scholarship: This scholarship is available for the needs of any Baldwin student in M.S.A.D. #55.

Marilyn Mason Memorial Scholarship: In honor of Marilyn Mason. This scholarship has been established to benefit middle school students who wish to pursue their love of music.

Dr. Paul Marston Scholarship: In honor of Dr. Paul Marston of Kezar Falls, this scholarship is to be awarded annually to a student or students who will be studying in the area of health.

Judy Matheson Memorial Fund: In memory of Judy Matheson. This scholarship is to be used for any need that the Cornish staff and Principal determine.

Maxwell Scholarship: This scholarship is awarded to a student or students going on to college in the field of Business or Teacher Education.

Bertha Moody Memorial Scholarship: In memory of Bertha Moody, a dedicated teacher for many years in the community. This scholarship is to be awarded annually to a deserving student or students preferably entering the teaching profession.

Moody Family Scholarship: In memory of Russell "Rusty" Moody, David Moody, Allen Moody, Rodney Moody Jr., and Aldo Edward Moody.. This scholarship is awarded annually to a deserving student or students.

Mount Cutler Grange P of H #152 Scholarship: To be awarded annually to a deserving student or students residing in the area that Mount Cutler Grange serves.

Horace Perry Scholarship Fund: In memory of Horace Perry of Kezar Falls. This scholarship is to be awarded annually to a student who is dedicated academically, shows enthusiasm and strong school spirit.

Norman G. & Cressie M. Pratt Fund: In memory of Norman & Cressie Pratt. This scholarship is to be awarded annually to two worthy senior class graduates, one from the Town of Parsonsfield and the other from the town of Cornish, who continue their education at the collegiate level or at a trade or business school.

Harry and Viola Pratt Scholarship: In memory of Mr. and Mrs. Pratt of Parsonsfield, this scholarship is awarded to the student from Parsonsfield with the highest scholastic rating.

Harriet Ridlon Scholarship: In memory of Harriet Ridlon, the interest from donations will go towards Dollars for Scholars.

Kerianne Sherman: In memory of Kerianne Sherman class of 2003. This scholarship will be awarded annually to a Sacopee graduate pursuing a degree in International Studies; Teacher of foreign language or Art; or a deserving Cornish student.

Skyler Fund: In memory of Skyler Carpenter. This scholarship has been established for the benefit of less fortunate students.

Stephen Smith Scholarship: In memory of Stephen Edward Smith, Class of 1969. This scholarship is awarded annually to a deserving student(s) from Parsonsfield.

L. Arnold Stacey Scholarship: In memory of L. Arnold Stacey. This scholarship is awarded annually to a well-rounded, deserving student who exhibits school spirit, enthusiasm, a sense of humor and perseverance.

Roland Stanley Scholarship: In memory of Roland Stanley of Kezar Falls, this scholarship is to be awarded annually to a deserving student or students.

James "Jimmy" Stewart Scholarship Fund: In memory of James "Jimmy" Stewart of Cornish, Class of 1982. This scholarship is to be awarded annually to a student who embodies his character and spirit - perseverance and the ability to overcome great personal challenges, a sense of humor and kindness towards others.

Francis Sullivan Post #154 (Boys State) of the American Legion: To be used to send Sacopee Valley High School students to Boys State.

WMTW Tower Scholarship: This scholarship will be awarded annually to Baldwin residents and graduate of Sacopee Valley High School who are enrolled in either/or a Liberal Arts 2 or 4 year college or a Vocational/Technical School.

Helen F. Wakefield Scholarship Fund: In memory of Ms. Wakefield of Kezar Falls, to be awarded annually to a student from Porter or Kezar Falls.

Joseph L. Watson Memorial Scholarship: In memory of Joseph L. Watson of East Parsonsfield, this scholarship has been established for the betterment of the sports program and athletes at Sacopee Valley High School.

The Earle D. Webster and Benjamin H. & Frances Webster Scholarship: This scholarship is to be awarded annually to a resident of the Town of Cornish who plans to further their education and who demonstrates a need for funds.

West Day Post #123: This scholarship is to be awarded annually to a deserving student or students.

Victor & Betty Zelman Scholarship: This scholarship is to be awarded annually to a student/students who will be attending any vocational school within the State of Maine and who live at the time of graduation in the Town of Hiram.
