

iPad Home Safety Information

Before bringing the device home parents should understand the following:

- Home internet access is not necessary for the local productivity software on the device to operate
- Home Internet access, if desired, is the responsibility of the parent
- Any and all after school computer use should always take place in a location where parents can monitor their child and the device.
- The MLTI device is not connected to the school filter when using home and private Internet connections.
- Apps can be blocked on the device by contacting your school's MLTI Building Technician
- Privately purchased internet safety software may be installed or configured by contacting your school's MLTI Building Technician
- Camera access can be removed from the ipad by contacting your school's MLTI Building Technician
- Parents should know who their students communicate with and know their student's logins/passwords
